Responsibilities:

Nurse Case Managers facilitate a cooperative effort between patients, parents, doctors, nurses, payers, and allied health care workers, community agencies and home care services, thus promoting a smooth journey through the entire span of care. The case manager facilitates the coordinated utilization of resources for maximization of health outcomes, patient/family satisfaction and financial outcomes. Collaborates proactively with all interdisciplinary team members and with a patient focus to facilitate and maximize client healthcare outcomes. The Case Manager will improve the efficiency in the outpatient clinics by ensuring appropriate appointments and appointment times for providers with their patients. This will increase the effectiveness of the provider patient encounters by allowing patients access to their primary care provider to maximize continuity.

Position Qualifications: To perform this job successfully, individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The individual must be self-motivated, enthusiastic, and able to think critically and evaluate each situation in relation to the other circumstances of the day. Ability to multitask is a must.
