This includes a full behavioral health Assessment (both AODA and mental health), determination of needs, development of the Master Treatment Plan and ongoing direct counseling services and Family Therapy. Home visits and community-based interventions are a major responsibility of this position. This position may occasionally require some evening/weekend hours to accommodate family schedules.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Master's Degree in Social Work, Psychology or Nursing with specialty in Substance Abuse and Mental Health. Two(2) years experience supervised experience providing intergraded behavioral health direct care services performed at a satisfactory level. Experience working with adolescent clients and families required. Experience in a cross cultural setting working with Alaska Native or Native American cultures strongly preferred. Licensure in Alaska as LPC, LCSW, LMSW, LMFT or equivalent for Medicaid billing . Dual Certification as a Substance Abuse Counselor highly preferred, but not required; the incumbent will be expected to pursue Certification. Ability to use basic office equipment: computer, copier, fax machine etc. Computer Literacy required.
