NATURE OF WORK: The Substance Abuse Therapist performs substance abuse counseling services including intake and assessment. In consultation with other team members, the Substance Abuse Therapist decides what combination of individual, group, and family therapies are appropriate to each client and deliver these services. Services may include service determination, case management, referral, counseling, and crisis stabilization. The Substance Abuse Therapist will carry an assigned caseload and will deliver services individually or as part of a team.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Licensed as an Independent Substance Abuse Counselor (LISAC) in the state of Arizona. If Licensed or certified out of state, must be Arizona certified within six months of employment
2. Two (2) years substance abuse experience
3. Certification as an ACCUDETTOX Specialist through the National Acupuncture Detoxification Association preferred
4. Successful work history with Indian populations and or other ethnic groups preferred
5. Bilingual English/Spanish preferred but not required
6. If in recovery, must be clean and sober for at least 2 years

AND

- ◆ Must possess and maintain a valid Arizona driver's license
- ◆ Must provide at least three (3) business-related reference letters
- ◆ Must pass background check and drug test. Fingerprinting requirement determined by funding and sensitivity of position

PASCUA YAQUI PREFERENCE ACTS OF 2000: Members of the Tribe shall be given absolute preference with respect to hiring and promotions for positions with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe. For persons who meet the above minimum required qualifications preferential treatment shall be based on the following criteria and shall be given in the following order: 1) Enrolled Member of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe 2) Spouses of Enrolled Members of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe 3) Enrolled Member of other recognized tribes 4) Other applicants.
