Summary of Responsibilities: Family Practice Physician works under the direction of the Director of Health Services and provides primary health care to the patients of the Perkins Family Clinic.

Essential Duties and responsibilities:

Includes the following: other duties may be assigned

- Provides comprehensive primary health care.
- Makes initial and continuing assessment of patients health status followed by appropriate intervention independently or by collaboration with other physician specialists.
- Refers patients to appropriate medical facilities or health care providers
- Collaborates with the Contract Health Services coordinator to provide referral services to specialty clinics/services
- Physician provides primary care to both Native American and non-Native populations.
- Obtains staff privileges at a commutable community hospital as required.

Qualifications:

The applicant must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skills, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Submit to drug testing as a condition of employment.

Education and/or Experience:

Applicant must be a Board Certified Family Practice Physician, either Medical Doctor (M.D.) and/or a Doctor of Osteopathy (D.O.) with a minimum of three years in practice.

Applicant must be fully licensed in the State of Oklahoma. License must also carry the designation as a Dispensing Physician.
