- To increase access and participation of youth and their families in injury prevention programs and activities.
- To implement a comprehensive seat belt and child passenger safety campaign.

**Accomplishments for
Year 1 – 2005**

- Met all project goals for the year –monthly activities
- Increased seat belt use to 84%
- Increased child safety seat use to 42%
- Obtained 3-year funding from the Rural Health Care Outreach Services
- Obtained 5 mini-grants (\$1,500 each) from the University of Arizona's College of Public Health
- MOU was signed with the Navajo Nation Department of Law Enforcement –Chinle District
- Started the National Fire Protection Association's First Nations Remembering When smoke alarm project in Pinon, AZ (to be completed by 3/07)
