**Project Goals**

- Injury Prevention Committee to work on reducing Injuries in the Osage Reservation.
- Child Car Seat Program and replenishing our supply of Car Seats.
- Increase by 20% the use of Child Safety Seats children 1-12 years of age on the Osage Nation Reservation.
- Passenger Safety training for tribal members and community.
- Conduct a “Bike Rodeo” to promote Helmet use among young children. This year we are Co-sponsoring with the Kiwanis Club and School system to provide a more comprehensive safety program. Bicycle education “Rules of the Road”.
- Provide Smoke Detectors and CO Detectors to elderly and eligible families.
- Injury Prevention committee plans for hosting several safety programs throughout the year such as: Halloween, Water, Bike, Fire, Buckle up, and after school Safety and others as they come up throughout the year.
- Sponsor a safe night for the teens to promote safe driving and non drinking.

**Accomplishments for Year  
1 - 2005**

- Hired Jody Carr as the Injury Prevention Coordinator
- Established a (8) eight person Advisory Committee consisting of members of the Tribe and Community
- Developed a Child Car Seat Program and distributed (60) SIXTY car seats.
- Provided a SNAP Course (Securing Native American Passengers) to the Community.
- Conducted a Bicycle Rodeo and gave out Helmets and (8) eight bikes
- Received CO detectors as a donation from Wal-Mart.
- Hosted a Water Safety Program with the Corps of Engineers at the area Lakes.
- Distribute Smoke and CO Detectors to eligible applicants.
- Sponsored a successful “Safe Night Out” for area teens to promote safe driving and no drinking.
- Developed partnerships with other safety programs for future collaborations in injury prevention.
