

# CHILDREN'S TRAINING GUIDE



This Guide includes the U.S. Fire Administration's *Sesame Street Fire Safety Station*. It contains stories, songs, creative activities, demonstrations, role-playing, and other activities that Head Start educators can use in the classroom to teach children basic fire safety. **Outcomes:** Upon completing this component, students will be able to:

- Demonstrate what to do when a smoke alarm or fire alarm goes off.
- Demonstrate stop, drop, and roll.

**Key Concepts:**

- A smoke alarm warns about fire.
- How to get out of a burning building and to stay out.
- If clothing catches on fire, stop, drop, and roll.

- *Sesame Street Fire Safety Station* Stories and Songs.
- Masking tape, tape recorder, coloring pens/pencils/crayons.
