Approach	Brainstorming Ideas (Risk Factors or Interventions)
Environment	-surfacing material in high-risk fall zones -clean playground of trip hazards
Education	-instruct children and teachers of playground fall hazards.
Enforcement	-playground equipment safety standards -enforcement of “safe play” policies (e.g., no running) -routine playground safety inspections.
