Mr. Tahsuda is a member of the Kiowa Tribe of Oklahoma. In addition to his duties as ALN, Mr. Tahsuda is the Director of the Office of Tribal Self-Determination in the Oklahoma City Area, a post he has held since 1992. He also serves as the Acting Director of Information Technology and Telecommunications for the Oklahoma Area. Mr. Tahsuda first joined the Oklahoma City Area Office in 1988 as a Health Systems Specialist in the Tribal Office. Previously he served as a Commissioned Officer of the Public Health Service with the IHS in Sacramento, California. He also worked on the Salt River reservation for the Pima-Maricopa Tribes as a Health Planner for four years. Mr. Tahsuda has a Bachelors Degree in Business Administration, Finance, from the University of Oklahoma. In 1980, he received his MPH in Health Administration from the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center.
