


# The Triple Aim:




- Improve the health of the population;



- 4 Cycles 10/1, 01/1, 04/1, 06/1 for “Community Directed Grants”
- Competitive RFA (Cycle 3 due 2/19/10)
- Training available on IHS Website to develop program and application
- All Areas will receive same amounts for FY 2010 and 2011

# SDPI



- 5<sup>th</sup> cycle: 09/30
- “Demonstration Projects” Diabetes Prevention (5) and Healthy Heart Projects (4)
- Funding remains same for FY 2010 & 2011 to function with less restrictions on participant eligibility
