


All IHS Areas Combined Immunization Coverage 2-Year Olds (4:3:1:3:3:1)



The 2 year old report looks at American Indian/Alaska Native children 19 – 35 months of age. Coverage is defined as the percentage of children who have received all of the following recommended vaccines: 4 doses of DTaP, 3 doses of Polio (IPV), 1 dose of MMR, 3 Doses of Hib, 3 doses of Hep B, and 1 dose of Varicella. This is often referred to as the 4:3:1:3:3:1 series.
