INTRODUCTIONS

Meeting, via conference call, started at 12:30 p.m. Total present: 10; voting members present: 6. Minutes of April 7, 1993 meeting were approved. The following agenda was presented:

GUIDELINES SUBMITTED

Isolation Rooms: CAPT Byrns discussed some criteria requirements for the Isolation Room. The general consensus is to provide doors from the corridor to anteroom, and from the anteroom to the patient room. Motion by CAPT. Harper to adopt this criteria, and was seconded by CDR. McFarland. All 6 members voted in favor of adopting this criteria. The IHS Health Facilities Planning Manual (HFPM) will be modified accordingly. Issues for the Isolation Rooms will be addressed under the DFPC Guideline No. 19.

Asbestos Abatement: Motion by CDR. Petersen to adopt Managing Asbestos In Place, A Building Owner's Guide to Operations and Maintenance Programs For Asbestos-Containing Materials, US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), latest edition. Seconded by CAPT. Byrns. All 6 members voted to adopt this guideline as noted. Each Area Office will develop their asbestos management program, using the latest EPA guideline. This guideline will be issued accordingly as a reference manual in the IHS Technical Handbook. DFM-HQ will develop an IHS Technical Handbook Chapter.

Alternate Power For Health Facilities: OES Seattle developed the proposed Technical Handbook Chapter but since all members had not received a copy for review, discussions were postponed until next month.


NEXT MEETING
