Items Discussed:

HFAC Decision Notices; OES Dallas did not receive their copy. There were no comments made except to correct the dates of acceptance on: Asbestos Abatement, from April 1993 to May 1993; and HVAC Design for Tuberculosis, from May 1993 to June 1993.

Alternate Power; A corrected copy will be mailed to IHS HQS by CAPT Harper. The final copy will be submitted for approval by Office of Environmental Health and Engineering (OEHE) Associate Director.

Feasibility Studies; A corrected copy will be mailed to IHS HQS by CAPT Harper. The final copy will be submitted for approval by OEHE Associate Director.

Value Engineering; Several issues were discussed, and all issues will be considered for the final copy. A motion by CAPT Taylor to adopt the VE as corrected was made. Seconded by CAPT Gallegos, and voted favorably by seven HFAC members. CAPT Byrns abstained. CAPT Byrns indicated that his staff still needs to review the VE; any comments will be forwarded to CAPT Harper. The final copy will be mailed to IHS HQS by CAPT Harper, and it will be submitted for approval by OEHE Associate Director.


CDC Guideline for Tuberculosis; This issue was postponed until next meeting.
