

4-1.3 DECISION NO. D-21

PROJECT FINAL REPORT

Issue:

Guidelines are needed for preparing the project final report which is required for all completed Indian Health Service (IHS) health care facilities and quarters construction projects, both IHS and federally assisted tribal construction. The final report is intended to provide a source of recommendations which may be reflected in the future design development and construction of all Indian Health Service health care facilities and quarters, including maintenance and improvement projects. Also, the final report can be used as a reference document for answering Congressional inquiries, planning and projecting needs, and justifying construction budgets.

Decision:

The Health Facilities Advisory Committee reviewed the draft Indian Health Service Technical Handbook Chapter, "Project Final Report," and approved it for inclusion in the Technical Handbook, following editorial revision.

This document will be issued as Chapter 24-8, Project Final Report, Part 24, Volume III, of the Technical Handbook for Environmental Health and Engineering.
