

4-1.3 DECISION NO. D-25

INTERIM LIFE SAFETY MEASURES

Issue:

Guidelines are needed for implementing Interim Life Safety Measures (ILSM) to compensate for existing major life safety deficiencies, hazards created by construction operations, and/or failure of life safety systems at Indian Health Service health care facilities and quarters.

Decision:

The Health Facilities Advisory Committee reviewed and approved the final draft of the Interim Life Safety Measures dated November 8, 1996, subject to editorial revision, and will be included in the Technical Handbook. Effective immediately, this guide will apply to all Indian Health Service installations.
