If slots have filled up for the day, you may be asked to return the following day to receive care. We apologize for any inconvenience.

We try to provide as much care as possible for our emergency patients, however, there are certain services that cannot be provided through the dental emergency clinic. These include procedures such as large fillings or complicated wisdom tooth extractions.

ROUTINE DENTAL CARE

Routine dental care includes annual examinations, regular cleanings, and fillings or sealants as needed. Protecting your oral health with routine check-ups may prevent painful emergency visits.

Youth

(6 months to 17 years)

Parents, schedule your baby's first exam as soon as their first tooth comes in. Your child should receive an exam every year after that, from infancy to adulthood.

Note: We recommend that you supervise your child's daily dental routine until 8yrs old.

Adults

(18 years and older)

Adults, we recommended you receive an exam once a year.
