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1.0 Introduction

Review these changes and add a copy of them to any printed documentation your site may be using for the Indian Health Service (IHS) Patient Care Component (PCC) Suite (BJPC) v2.0. These changes will be integrated into future versions of the software and user manuals. These changes will no longer be considered an addendum at the time of the next version release.

This addendum only provides written guidance on changes made in the patch that are relevant to the user. To see a list of all changes, please refer to the patch notes for each of the respective patches.

1.1 Summary of Changes

Patch 25 includes the following additions/changes to the BJPC Management Reports functionality:

- AUD Option Run Random Sample of Visits by DX and Date by Primary ICD POV.
- AUD Option Run Random Sample of Visits by DX and Date by Primary and Secondary ICD POV.
- PGEN and VGEN addition of Religious Preference as a selection item.
- PGEN and VGEN addition of PHR Access as a selection item.
- PGEN and VGEN addition of PHR Handout Fields as a selection item.
- QMAN addition of the Suicide Risk Assessment Exam attribute.
- QMAN addition of the Suicide Screening Exam attribute.

2.0 Patch 25 Changes

Patch 25 includes the following changes to the APCL Management Reports manual.

2.1 Run Random Sample of Visits by DX and Date by Primary and Secondary ICD POV

2.1.1 By Primary ICD POV




Figure 2-1: AUD Random Sample of Visits by DX and Date report by Primary ICD POV

When running the AUD Random Sample of Visits by DX and Date report (Figure 2-1), users have the option to select only those visits by a Primary ICD POV.

2.1.2 By Primary and Secondary ICD POV

When running the AUD Random Sample of Visits by DX and Date report (Figure 2-2), users have the option to select only those visits by a Primary and Secondary ICD POV.




Figure 2-5: PGEN Visit Selection Menu showing PHR Handout Given visit selection




Figure 2-7: PGEN Visit Selection Menu showing PHR Access visit selection




Figure 2-8: PGEN PHR Access selection option




Figure 2-9: VGEN Visit Selection Menu showing Religious Preference visit selection




Figure 2-11: VGEN Visit Selection Menu showing PHR Handout Given visit selection

2.3 QMAN Suicide Risk Assessment

Patch 25 adds the Suicide Risk Assessment as an attribute selection in QMAN.

In QMAN, search the PCC database and select **Living Patients**. Select the attribute **Suicide Risk Assessment** (Figure 2-15).

2.4 QMAN Suicide Screening

Patch 25 adds the SUICIDE Risk Assessment as an attribute selection in QMAN.

In QMAN, search the PCC database and select **Living Patients**. Select the attribute **Suicide Screening** (Figure 2-18).
