- 2. The Charge Nurse finishes orders in RPMS as follows:
 - a. Log on to RPMS.
 - b. Type **NURS** and press Enter.
 - c. Type **IOE** and press Enter.
 - d. Type patient name or chart # and press Enter.
 - e. Type **NO** and press Enter for New Order Entry.
 - f. Select Drug option displays; **do not** type drug here; press Enter.
 - g. Select IV Type option displays; **do not** type medications; press Enter.
 - h. Select Action displays; Type **SO** for Select Order and press Enter.
 - i. Select Order displays; enter all pending medication numbers (e.g., 1-4 or 1, 2, 3, 4) and press Enter.
 - Type FN and press Enter to finish the order.
 - k. Check the order to make sure everything is correct. Type ED and press enter to edit order if necessary. If no edit is necessary, type AC to accept the order and press Enter.
 - Check to make sure the order is correct, type VF to verify order, and press Enter.
 - m. Press Enter again. The order will be verified and made active in EHR.

For Orders entered by the physician directly into EHR (after hours), the Charge Nurse will follow the preceding instructions to finish medications in RPMS and make medications active in EHR.
