

Summary of Service Area and Demographic Information



- FY 2018 User Population Billings Area = 71,235
- ► The Billings Area consists of 8 Reservations -BlackFeet, Crow, Ft. Belknap, Ft. Peck, Northern Cheyenne, Wind River (Eastern Shoshone/Northern Arapaho), Flathead and Rocky Boy
- 7 Direct Service Tribes & 2 Self-Governance (CSKT & Rocky Boy)
- ► There are also 5 Urban Health Centers in the Billings Area- Helena/Great Falls/Billings/Missoula/Butte
- ► There are 12 Federally operated Hospitals and Satelite Clinics in the Billings Area.
