Accreditation emergency funds may also be used, as needed, to carry out activities typically funded under the Indian Health Facilities account. In addition, the report language accompanying the Act specifies that no less than \$20,000,000 is directed to facilities for purchased/referred care, replacement of third party revenues lost as a result of decertification, replacement of third-party carryover funds expended to respond to decertification, and reasonable costs of achieving recertification, including recruitment costs necessary to stabilize staffing."
