Dear Urban Indian Organization Leader:

On behalf of the Indian Health Service (IHS), I am writing to initiate Urban Confer to seek your input on developing and implementing an infrastructure study on facilities operated by Urban Indian Organizations (UIOs).

The December 27, 2020-enacted Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (Pub. L. No. 116-260) (the Act), provides the IHS with a total fiscal year (FY) 2021 appropriation of \$6.4 billion. The Act's Joint Explanatory Statement for Division G provides appropriations for the Department of the Interior, the IHS, Environmental Protection Agency, the Forest Service, and related agencies for FY 2021. Specifically, \$1,000,000 is provided to conduct an infrastructure study for facilities run by UIOs. The infrastructure study will be a first step towards creating a comprehensive action plan to address the most critical challenges faced by UIOs.
