Dear Urban Indian Organization Leader:

I am writing to initiate Urban Confer on exploring the formation of an Urban Interagency Workgroup with other Federal agencies.

By letter dated February 3, 2022, 14 Senators signed a letter requesting that President Biden and Vice President Harris form an Urban Indian Interagency Workgroup to identify needs and develop strategies to improve services provided to urban American Indian and Alaska Native populations. In response, on May 2, 2022, the Indian Health Service (IHS) sent an update to Senator Alex Padilla indicating that the IHS would explore forming an Urban Indian Interagency Workgroup to ensure Urban Indian health care needs are considered at the local, regional, and national levels.
