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1.0 Introduction

Please review these changes and add a copy of them to any printed documentation your site may be using for the Indian Health Service (IHS) Immunization Tracking System (BI namespace) version 8.5 (v8.5) component. These changes will be integrated into future versions of the software and user manuals. These changes will no longer be considered an addendum at the time of the next version release.

This addendum only provides written guidance on changes made in the patch that are relevant to the user. To see a list of all changes please refer to the patch notes for each of the respective patches.

1.1 Summary of Changes

• Vaccine Table updated with latest CDC additions:

-	Typhoid, CV	CVX 190

- Updated the Adolescent Report to reflect recommended HPV 2- dose schedule.
- Updated the Adolescent Report meningococcal terminology to CDC standard.
- Updated the Two-Yr-Old Rates Report rotavirus vaccine logic to include 2-dose Rotavirus schedule.
- MENING-B added to the vaccine table along with the ability to turn off MEN-B forecasting.
- Updated manager menu Lot Number Add/Edit option help text to reflect previous patch changes.
- Patients with an egg allergy are no longer contraindicated from receiving influenza vaccines per ACIP recommendation.
- HEP A no longer forecasts as due after the Twinrix CVX 104 combination vaccine series is completed.
- High risk patients <65 years old no longer forecast as due to receive PCV13 vaccine once they have received the PPSV23 vaccine.
- Fixed Export Immunization option bug where "No records to be exported" was returned when records did exist.

2.1 Vaccine Table Changes

2.1.1 MENING-B Added to Vaccine Group Table.

MENIN-G B is added as a vaccine group to the table. Select C Change Vaccine Group to turn MENING-B forecasting off for your site. See Figure 2-1.

2.2 Report Changes

2.2.1 Adolescent Report: MENACWY

The Adolescent Report meningococcal terminology is changed from MEN to MENACWY to distinguish between the two meningococcal vaccines available for use with different age recommendations.

2.2.2 Adolescent Report: HPV

The report is updated to reflect the CDC/ACIP 2-dose schedule for HPV vaccine series completion. Report changes are as follows:

- 1. Fully vaccinated 2 doses, fully vaccinated 3 doses, and total fully vaccinated (2 or 3 doses) added to each male and female section.
- 2. New section added for males and females combined for HPV1, 2, and 3, and fully vaccinated 2 doses, fully vaccinated 3 doses, and totally fully vaccinated.

2.2.3 Two-Yr-Old Rates Report: Rotavirus

The Two-Yr-Old Report is updated as follows:

- 1. The 2-dose ROTA1 vaccine is added to the report.
- 2. The 2-dose Rotavirus is included in the composite sections that include Rotavirus and counted as up-to-date.
