1.0 Introduction

Please review these changes and add a copy of them to any printed documentation your site may be using for the Indian Health Service (IHS) Patient Care Component (PCC) Suite (BJPC) v2.0. These changes will be integrated into future versions of the software and user manuals. These changes will no longer be considered an addendum at the time of the next version release.

This addendum only provides written guidance on changes made in the patch that are relevant to the user. To see a list of all changes please refer to the patch notes for each of the respective patches.

1.1 Summary of Changes

Patch 22 includes the following additions/changes to the BJPC functionality:

- New V Delivery (VDEL) mnemonic which allows users to document delivery and newborn birth information.
- Refused/Declined Service (REF) mnemonic modified to allow entry of both date and time.

2.0 Patch 22 Changes – Mnemonics

2.1 New Mnemonic VDEL (V Delivery)

Use the V Delivery mnemonic to document a patient's delivery information.

The data entry fields are as follows:

- Labor Established (Date/Time)
- Labor Established SNOMED (Systemized Nomenclature of Medicine) Concept IDs (choose from list)
- Labor Induced: if yes, choose from a list of Labor Induction SNOMED Concept IDs

Users have the option to document newborn data. The data entry fields are as follows:

- Newborn Delivery Date/Time
- EGA at Delivery (If there are EGA [Estimated Gestational Age] measurements on file between a day before and the delivery date, the EGA will auto-populate.)
- Sex at Birth
- Live/Stillborn

Users have the option to add another newborn entry, edit the existing newborn entry, or delete a newborn entry.

2.2 Modified Mnemonic – REF (Refused/Declined Service)

The REF mnemonic is modified to allow users to enter a date and a time that the patient refused or declined service. Previously, users could only enter a date.
