
Influenza Surveillance Report

IHS Influenza Awareness System (IIAS)

(Week 25: June 15, 2020 - June 21, 2020)

- Influenza-like-illness (ILI) activity in IHS is low at 0.7%, below the IHS baseline of 1.96%
 - o All IHS Areas besides for Bemidji reported having lower ILI activity
- National ILI activity reported by CDC is low
 - o CDC's ILINet ILI activity for week 25 was 0.8%, below the ILINet baseline (2.4%) and the IHS baseline.
- To date, IHS has administered 292,503 doses of influenza vaccine.
- Overall, 37.0% of the IHS Active Clinical population received an influenza vaccine this season.








