

Influenza-like Illness Surveillance Report IHS Influenza Awareness System (IIAS) (Week 40: 10/03/2021 - 10/09/2021)

- IHS national Influenza-like illness (ILI) activity is low at 0.4%, below the IHS baseline of 1.93%
  - o Seven out of eleven IHS Areas reported a decrease in ILI activity, while other IHS Areas reported having consistent or slightly decreased ILI activity from the previous week.
  - This week's IHS ILI activity is below the CDC's ILINet ILI activity for week 40 (1.92%), below the ILINet baseline (2.5%) and the IHS baseline of 1.93%.
- To date, IHS has administered 49,675 doses of influenza vaccine.
- Overall, 7.5% of the IHS Active Clinical population ages 6 months and older has received an influenza vaccine this season to date.
- The data within this report reflects data gathered after the installation of ILI/H1N1 Surveillance Export (APCL v3.0 patch 33) at most sites. Patch change request information can be provided upon request.








