System for Award Management

This website is where all IHS Sources Sought Notices and Solicitations are issued for all acquisitions over \$25K. All federal agencies are required to post their intent to procure for all acquisitions over \$25K. Companies can register their business in sam.gov. It is also very important that companies respond to Requests for Information and Sources Sought Notices on sam.gov or if they receive an email from a contracting official, COR, or IHS program official seeking information about capabilities as part of market research. <https://sam.gov/content/home>
