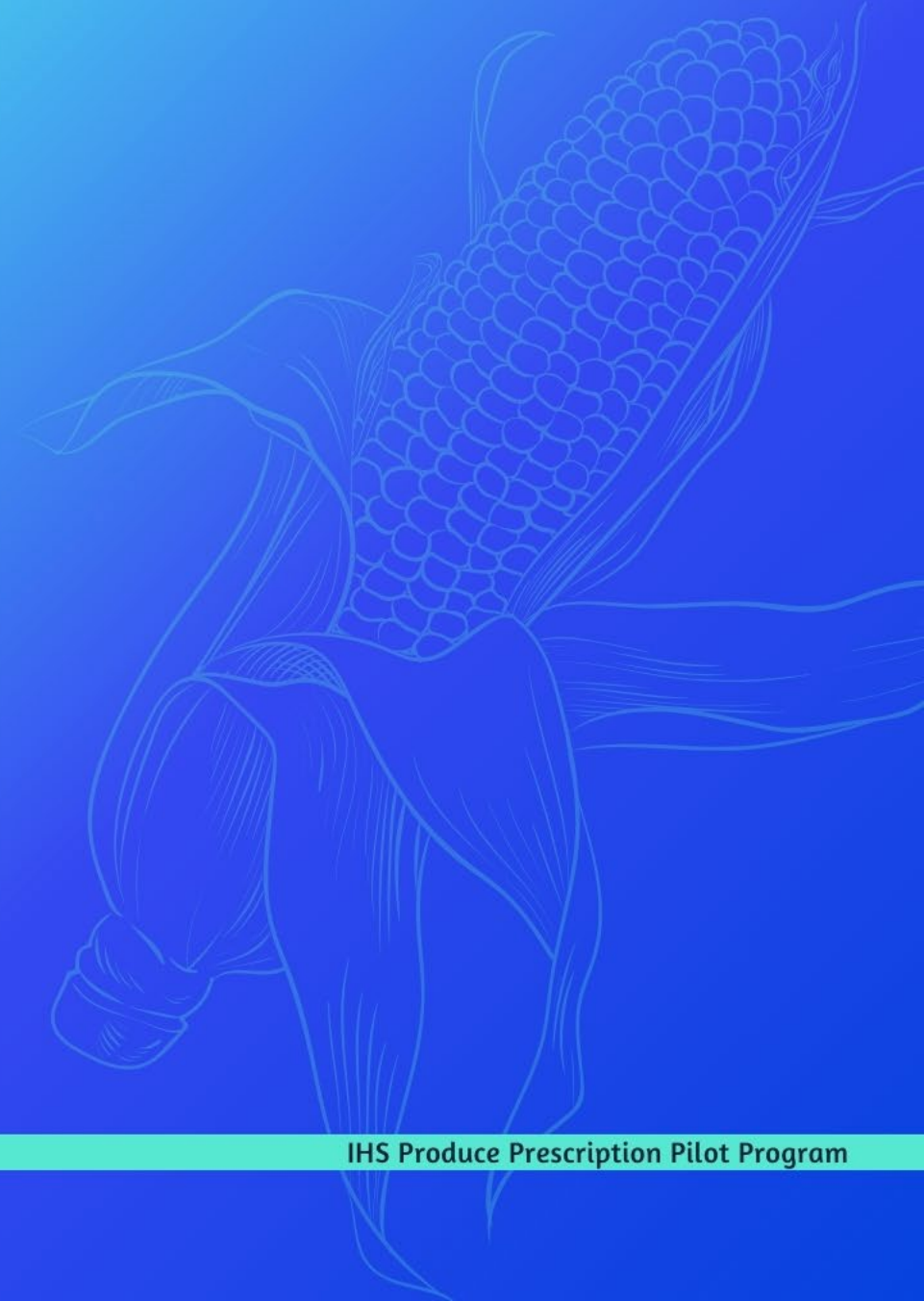

Application Materials

Tips for Using the P4 Project Narrative

- Open “original version” link.
- Ensure the Project Narrative is in Word format (not PDF).
- Download (Save) a copy of the Project Narrative template to your computer.
- Save the completed document – do not print and/or scan.
- Proofread to ensure all fields are completed and to minimize grammatical/spelling errors.

The template is provided for submitting the required information and to prepare a successful (and complete) Project Narrative.

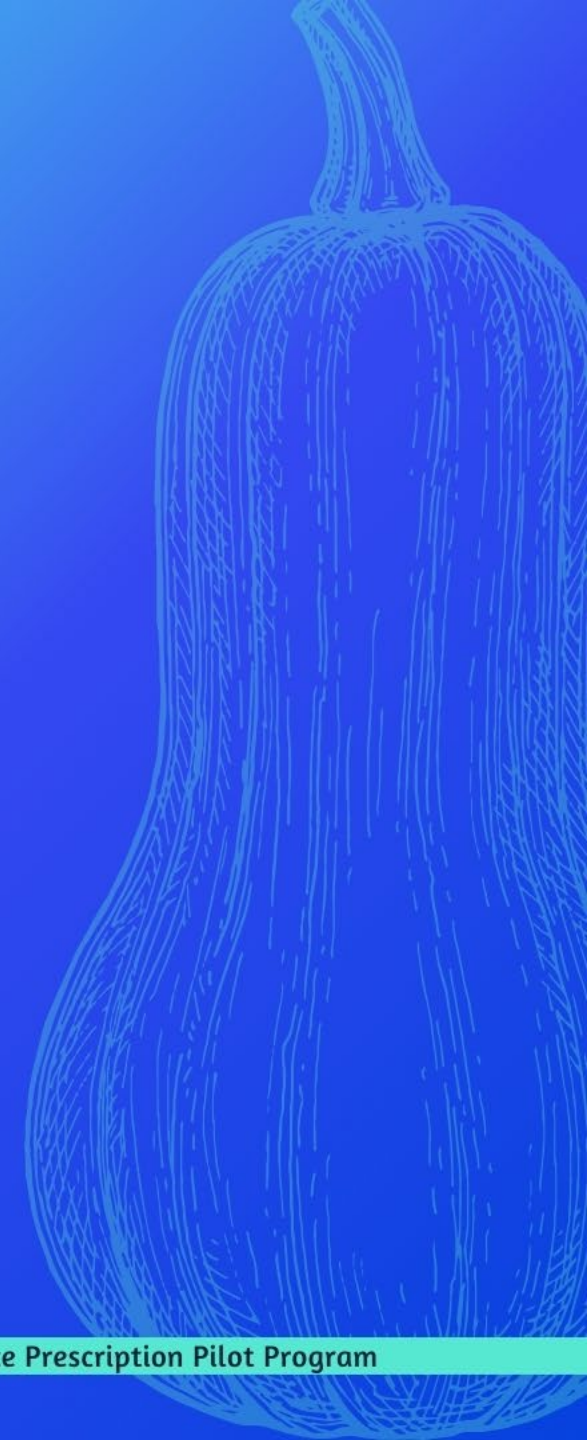

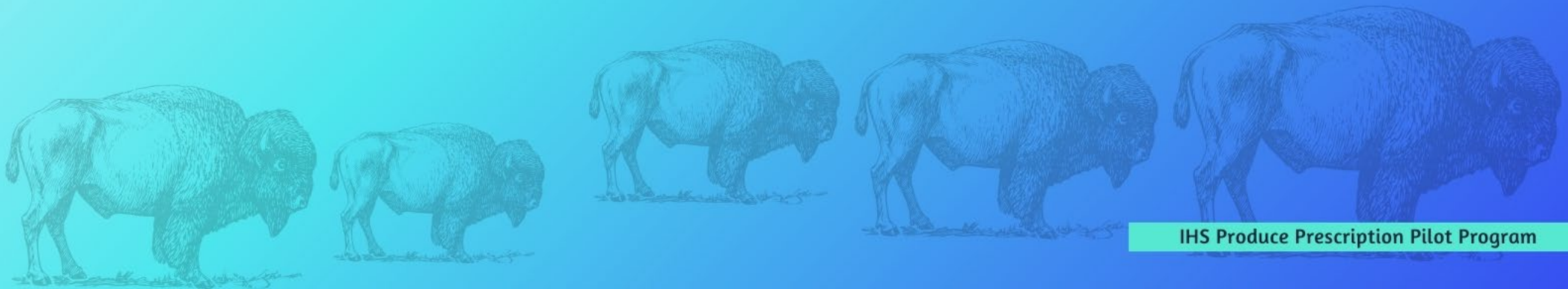
Submitting the Continuation Application



Submitting Your Application in GrantSolutions

1. Log into [GrantSolutions](#).
2. Click on “Apply for Non-Competing Award”; this link will be available under “My Grants List”.
3. Complete online forms and upload file attachments for each enclosure in the application kit.
4. Once forms and uploads are complete, verify them and then submit the application using the buttons and prompts provided on the GrantSolutions screen.

Review of Applications



Application Screening

- All applications will be screened for adherence to the instructions from the DGM and DDTP, including submission of all required documents.
- Applicants who do not submit all required documents in the correct format may be contacted to provide the proper documentation before their application can be reviewed.
 - This may result in a delayed NoA and/or Special Grant Conditions on their NoA issuing funds for 2024.



Application Review

Grant applications that pass screening will be reviewed by the Program Officer, or their designee, based on the following:

- Compliance with the Terms and Conditions outlined in the FY23 NoA
- Satisfactory business (fiscal) review of the FY24 application
- Satisfactory programmatic review of the FY24 application, including:
 - Completeness of information from the Project Narrative template
 - Documented plan for continued work and evaluation in FY24



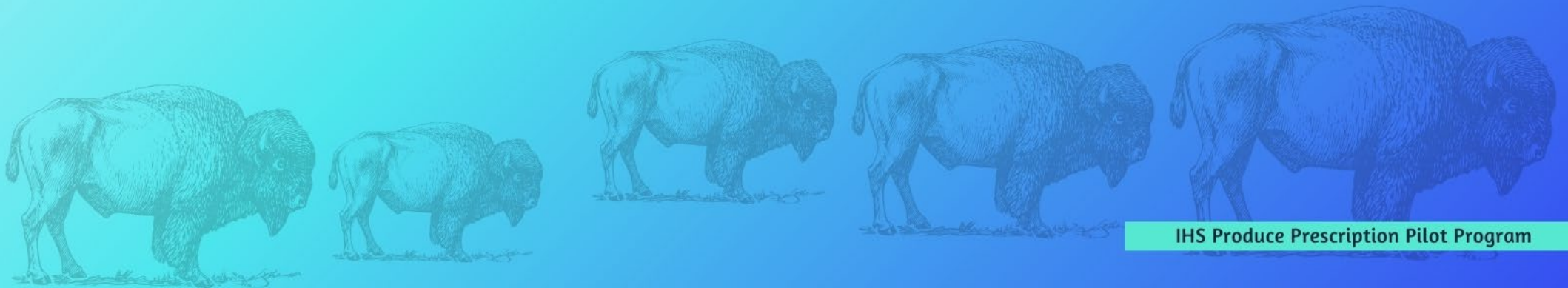
Application Review (cont'd)

- Grantees with applications that are approved with restrictions will have Special Grant Condition(s) placed on their FY24 Notice of Award.
- Special Grant Conditions are notes added onto the NoA that describe missing documentation or revisions needed.
- Some Special Grant Conditions may also place funding restrictions until specified documents or revisions are submitted and approved.
