STAGES OF THE DISEASE:



<u>HEALTH</u>

- Gums are pink & firm
- No gum bleeding
- Teeth don't move

GINGIVITIS

- Gums are red, swollen, bleed, and tender
 - Bad breath develops
 - Disease is reversible





PERIODONTAL DISEASE

- Damage has happened
- Gums and bone are lost
- Teeth get "pockets" and may begin to move





ADVANCED DISEASE

- More damage occurs
- Teeth become loose
- Teeth may need to be taken out

DIABETES - complications
