**Accomplishments
for Year 1 –
2005-2006**

- Head Start Education Plan Completed – 50% increase in knowledge at the end of the school year.
- San Diego Riverside Charter School Injury Prevention Education completed with 39% increase in knowledge.
- Jemez BIA Day School Injury Prevention Education completed with 42% increase in knowledge.
- Completed 50 Home Safety Assessments and installed home safety modifications for elderly and physically impaired tribal members.
- The Animal Control Ordinance provided services to 150 pet owners.
- Successfully requested Child Restraints.
- Successfully reapplied for 2006-2007 funding. (Grants.Gov)
