The Medicare and Medicaid Electronic Health Record (EHR) Incentive Programs provide incentive payments to eligible professionals (EP), eligible hospitals (EH), and critical access hospitals (CAH) that successfully demonstrate meaningful use of certified EHR technology. This course describes and explains the criteria that EPs, EHs, and CAHs must meet in Stage 1 and Stage 2 to qualify for these incentive payments using a 2014 Certified Electronic Health Record Technology.
