SHOSHONE-BANNOCK TRIBES

- Located in Southeastern Idaho
- Reservation 544,000 acres
- 5,681 enrolled tribal members, most living on the reservation
- Service population around 16,000





SHOSHONE-BANNOCK TRIBES



Through self-governing rights

- Fort Bridger Treaty of 1868
- Indian Reorganization Act of 1934

Tribes manage schools, post office, grocery store, waste disposal, agriculture and commercial businesses, rural transits, casino, convention center hotel and more.


