

- ❖ Residential Program for boys 12-17
  - ❖ Accommodates 10 residents
- ❖ Short term or long term residential care
- ❖ Substance Abuse and/or Mental Health diagnosis
- ❖ Residents may be dependents of the state, wards of juvenile court, or privately placed

The focus of the program is to teach the residents practical skills:

- House Keeping
- Meal preparation
- Laundry
- Conflict resolution
- Respect for self and others

Residents may help in the community garden as well as the TLC Garden.




**Outdoor activities include: hiking, fishing, swimming in the Eel River, day trips to the ocean and camping.**



Recovery and Treatment Services include: Clinical Evaluation and Assessment, Chemical Dependency Education and Counseling, Mental Health Counseling, Family Therapy, 12-Step/Support Groups, Red Road Talking Circle, Cultural Awareness Education and Activities, General Healthcare and Medication Management. Some staff will soon receive White Bison Program training.



**The Yuki Trails TLC building was designed to support close supervision of the residents.**


