# Priority #1 OBESITY/DIABETES

### Obesity

#### Childhood Weight Control

- Long term measure, no 2014 target but data collected
- Reports on percentage of children 2-5 with BMI at the 95<sup>th</sup> or higher percentile
- □ 2014 result show a decrease from 24.6% to 22.6%
  - Very close to the IHS national result of 22.8%

### Diabetes

- □ Five measures are reported in budget
  - Good Glycemic Control
  - Controlled BP <140/90
  - LDL Assessed
  - Nephropathy Assessed
  - Retinopathy Exam
- □ In 2014:
  - 1 measure has no comparable 2013 data due to 2014 measure logic changes
    - Nephropathy Assessed

- 1 measures improved in performance
  - **Retinopathy Exam**
- **3** measures declined in performance
  - □ Good Glycemic Control
  - $\square \quad Controlled BP < 140/90$
  - □ LDL Assessed
- 3 of 4 measures with actual 2014 targets did not meet the target:
  - $\square \quad \text{Controlled BP} < 140/90$
  - □ LDL Assessed
  - **Retinopathy Exam**

### Behavioral Health/Mental Health

- Three budget measures for which we have CA specific data:
  - Depression Screening
    - □ Percentage of patients aged 18 and older screened for depression
  - Domestic Violence/Intimate Partner Violence (DV/IPV)
     Screening
    - □ Percentage of female patients aged 15 to 40 screened for DV/IPV
  - Alcohol Screening (FAS Prevention)
    - Percentage of female patients aged 15-44 screened for alcohol use

#### □ In 2014:

- None of the three BH measures met their target
- Only one of the three measures improved over the 2013 result

## YOUTH REGIONAL TREATMENT CENTERS

Priority #4

### Youth Regional Treatment Centers (YRTCs)

### California's first IHS-operated YRTCs

- Residential chemical dependence treatment
- □ IHS-eligible youth, ages 12-17
- □ Two California YRTCs: southern and northern
- □ 32 beds at each facility

### Southern California YRTC

Status: design phase

#### Milestones:

- Purchase.....October 2011
- □ Dedication of the land......March 2012
- □ Construction.....November 2014

### Northern California YRTC

#### Status: acquiring the site

#### Milestones:

- □ Acquired site.....January 2013
- □ Dedication of the land.....July 2013
- Facility design and construction.....pending funds availability

### Youth Regional Treatment Centers

#### Total budget need = \$37 million

- Both YRTCs are in the "Planned Facility Construction Budget" (an IHS planning document)
- □ To date, Congress authorized: Both site-acquisitions (\$2.4 M), design and construction funds for the South YRTC (\$17 M)
- Future phases subject to annual Congressional appropriations (design and construction for the North, and operations funding for the South—all proposed in FY15 Federal Budget)

### MSPI Area Projects

- Reimburse residential treatment costs for youths
- Recommend "Universal Screening" for BH
   GPRA clinical measures
- Advocate screening both sexes and begin at age 14 years old
- Install EHR reminders and screening bundles
   & demonstrate using these tools

### MSPI Area Projects

- Assist with funding for Robert Sundance
   Health Generation Summer Camp (through
   UAII Alcohol Program)
  - Over 150 AI/AN kids participated in 2014
- Assist with funding Round Valley's Fit Kid/Fit Teen Program

### Other MSPI Projects

- Purchase 37 video conferencing equipment (units) at Tribal & Urban (T/U) health clinics
- Provide expert tele-medicine support
- □ Support U.C. Davis psychiatry services
  - 12 T/U programs contract for psychiatry care
- Behavioral Health Kiosk/Front Desk Demonstration Project
  - Currently at Riverside/San Bernardino
  - Consolidated and Round Valley will be participating soon
