- 17 Health Programs who represent 81 Tribes

FY 2016 Budget Recommendations

- 1st Recommendation Phase In Full Funding of IHS Total Needs Based Budget of \$28.7 Billion over 12 Years
- 2nd Recommendation Increase FY 2016 IHS Budget to \$5.2 Billion
- 3rd Recommendation Restore Cuts/Shortfalls in FY 2013 -15
- 4th Recommendation Permanent Exemption from Sequestration
- 5th Recommendation Fund Indian Health Care Improvement Act New Authorities





FY 2016 National Budget Work Session

- All CA health priority budget line increases were included in the National IHS budget
- \$40 million CSC shortfall has been included for new and expanded programs
- All 12 Areas recommended funding for Federal and Tribal pay, inflation (medical and non-medical) and population growth
- Policy Recommendations: Advance Appropriation for the IHS and Medicare Like Rates for non-hospital providers





National HHS Tribal Budget Consultation

- HHS hosted the 16th Annual HHS budget consultation on March 6 and 7 in Washington D.C.
- Attendees included tribal leaders and representatives, Indian organization leadership as well as HHS leadership and staff
- IHS Budget Formulation workgroup presented the budget recommendations
