- Process should be Efficient
- Minimize Litigation
- Government to Government Relationship
- Minimize burdens imposed upon Tribes and IHS
- Assure Consistency
- Assure Transparency
- Built on trust among IHS and Tribes
- On a regular basis the Policy will be reviewed to ensure it is working

CSC Workgroup Meetings

August 16, 2017 in Tulsa, Oklahoma

- March 6-7, 2018 in Albuquerque, NM
 - Dear Tribal Leaders Letter December 21, 2017
 - Temporarily Rescinded 6-3.2E(3) which addresses duplication
 - The Tribal workgroup formally objected to the rescission as we were not consulted with nor were Tribal Leaders

CSC Workgroup Meetings

- March 6-7, 2018 Continued
 - The Tribal workgroup formally objected to the rescission on January 3, 2018 as we were not consulted with nor were Tribal Leaders
 - 13 Cases were provided by IHS that IHS stated justified their decision to rescind the policy
- Additional meetings are in the works for 2018 to discuss an upcoming Dear Tribal Leaders Letter on CSC and to continue working on the Policy.

California Tribal Data

- 26 Tribal Programs have a negotiated Indirect Cost Rate from the DOI or HHS.
- 13 Tribal Programs negotiate directly with IHS and have Indirect Type Costs.
 - Through discussion at this last workgroup meeting, programs with Indirect Type costs are having to go through detailed negotiations because of IHS's interpretation of the CSC Policy.
