

Services vs Facilities Appropriations






IHS Facilities Appropriations

- There are 5 line items within the I.H.S. Facilities Appropriation
 - 1. Health Care Facilities Construction (HCFC)
 - 2. Maintenance and Improvement
 - 3. Equipment
 - 4. Sanitation Facilities Construction
 - 5. Facilities and Environmental Support
 - Facilities Support
 - Environmental Health Support
 - Office of Environmental Health and Engineering Support



Annual Healthcare Facilities Appropriation versus Total Need



Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act

- Became law on Nov. 15, 2021
- Provides \$3.5 B to Sanitation Facilities Construction Program
- \$700 M per year for 5 years
- Up to \$2.2 B for projects that exceed the economical unit cost
- 3% for salaries, expenses, and administration (not available to contracted and compacted Tribes and Tribal Organizations)
- 0.5% for Office of Inspector General
- One-time funding

FAAB Accomplishments

- Produced and updated an annual 2022 Facilities Appropriation Information Report (FAIR)
- Advocated for Demonstration Projects to not be restricted in size and/or scope
- Analyzed Joint Venture 2015 & 2020 applications and demonstrated Isolation Factor in scoring put some CA tribes at a disadvantage when site close to existing ER Level I, II or III in major cities
- FAAB Letters
 - To IHS Director endorsing to increase Small Ambulatory Program (SAP) threshold from \$2 million to \$4 million per awardee, establishing 105l Lease program metrics with request for additional resources and opening Joint Venture Construction Program to 105l Leases too (outcome of this letter is pending)
- Attended Quarterly FAAB Meetings scheduled in June, Sept. and Dec. 2022 and March 2023

FAAB Plans

- Delegate SAP Program from HQ to Area Offices (pending consultation)
- Study impact of Davis-Bacon Act wages on SAP Projects
- Requested an analysis of Facilities Support Account (FSA) [Facilities Staffing Levels]
- Report to Congress (RTC) due in 2026 [last RTC submitted in 2021] [every 5 years]
- Advocate for fair funds distribution once Revised Health Facilities Construction Priority System (R-HFCPS) is implemented
- Next Quarterly FAAB Meetings scheduled in June 28-29, Sept. 13-14 and Dec. 5-6, 2023
