CRS 2013

- Three versions of CRS are planned to be released
 - CRS v13.0 – Released November 30, 2012
 - CRS v13.0 patch 1 – Estimated release date is March 2013
 - CRS v13.1 – Estimated release date is October 2013

General Changes - v13.0

- Changed report titles from GPRA & PART to GPRA/GPRAMA
- Added functionality to run the GPRA Dashboard report by primary provider, and to choose the GPRA year for which to run the report
- Removed the National GPRA & PART Height and Weight Local Data File

National GPRA/GPRAMA Report Changes - v13.0

- **Diabetes: Glycemic Control**
 - Added measure for A1c < 8 – this is the new GPRAMA measure
 - Deleted previous GPRA measure of A1c < 7
 - Updated logic to look for the last A1c done on a visit if there is more than one test with results for a visit
- **Diabetes: Blood Pressure Control**
 - Added measure for blood pressure less than (<) 140/90 - this is the new GPRA measure
 - Deleted previous GPRA measure of blood pressure less than (<) 130/80
 - Added service code and clinic code exclusions to blood pressures used in calculation to exclude those taken in the hospital or surgery visits
- **Diabetes: Nephropathy Assessment**
 - Deleted POV code 585.5 from ESRD definition

National GPRA/GPRAMA Report Changes - v13.0

- **Diabetic Retinopathy**
 - Excluded patients with bilateral blindness from the denominator
 - Added measures for JVN visits, Ophthalmology visits, and Optometry visits
- **Dental Sealants**
 - Added rate measure previously in GPRA Developmental report, with age range updated to 2-15 and age breakdowns
 - Added age breakdown measure to existing count measure
 - Added logic to only count 0007 code if it is not documented on the same visit as one of the ADA or CPT codes
- **Topical Fluoride**
 - Added rate measure previously in GPRA Developmental report, with age range updated to 1-15 and age breakdowns
 - Added age breakdown measure to existing count measure

National GPRA/GPRAMA Report Changes - v13.0

- **Childhood Immunizations**
 - Deleted 43133 and 431331 combination measures
 - Updated GPRAMA combo measure to look for three or four HiB - the new combo is called 4313*314
 - Updated HiB measure to look for three or four Hib
 - Removed contraindications for OPV
- **Cancer Screening: Pap Smear Rates**
 - Added measure for ages 25-64 with Pap Smear in the past four years, previously in GPRA Developmental report - this is the new GPRA measure
 - Deleted previous GPRA measure of patients aged 21-64 with Pap Smear in the past three years
 - Deleted POV code V76.2 from Pap Smear definition
 - Moved POV code V76.47 from Pap Smear definition to hysterectomy definition

National GPRA/GPRAMA Report Changes - v13.0

- **Colorectal Cancer Screening**
 - Removed measures with old logic that were previously in the GPRA report
 - Added topic and measures previously in GPRA Developmental report titled “Colorectal Cancer Screening (Revised Logic #1-HEDIS)” - this contains the new GPRA measure
 - Updated procedure code 45.8 to 45.8* in total colectomy definition
- **Tobacco Cessation**
 - Removed measures with old logic that were previously in the GPRA report
 - Added topic and measures previously in GPRA Developmental report
 - GPRA measure changed to patients who received tobacco cessation counseling, received a prescription for a tobacco cessation aid, or quit their tobacco use anytime during the Report Period.

National GPRA/GPRAMA Report Changes - v13.0

- Obesity Assessment
 - Removed topic from GPRA report
- Childhood Weight Control
 - Removed topic from GPRA report
- Controlling High Blood Pressure – Million Hearts
 - Added new topic (NQF 0018)
- Comprehensive CVD-Related Assessment
 - Deleted old measures and replaced them with measures previously in GPRA Developmental report
 - Added logic to look at Patient Goal file for lifestyle education definition
- Breastfeeding Rates
 - Changed “PART” label to “GPRA”

GPRA Developmental Report Changes - v13.0

- GPRA Developmental Measures

- Added the following new GPRA Developmental measures:

- Access to Dental Service (pre-natal or nursing mother visit)
- Cancer Screening: Pap Smear Rates (Pap Smear + HPV visit)

- Removed the following new GPRA Developmental measures:

- Diabetes: Blood Pressure Control
- Diabetic Retinopathy
- Dental Sealants
- Topical Fluoride
- Childhood Immunizations (4:3:1:3/4:3:1:4 combo and 3 or 4 HiB)
- Cancer Screening: Pap Smear Rates (Pap Smear in past 4 years)
- Colorectal Cancer Screening (Revised Logic #1-HEDIS)
- Tobacco Cessation (Developmental Logic)
- Comprehensive CVD-Related Assessment
- Use of High-Risk Medications in the Elderly

GPRA Developmental Report Changes - v13.0

- GPRA Developmental Measures
 - Updated HIV Screening to look for positive results in either HIV-1 or HIV-2 tests
 - Updated codes in the following measures:
 - Childhood Immunizations
 - Cancer Screening: Pap Smear Rates
 - Comprehensive Cancer Screening

Developmental Measures - v13.0 (cont'd)

▫ Access to Dental Service

- Den: All pregnant or breastfeeding female User Population patients with no documented miscarriage or abortion.
- Num: Patients with documented pre-natal or nursing mother dental visit during the Report Period. NOTE: This numerator does NOT include refusals.
 - This measure looks to see which pregnant or breastfeeding patients have had a pre-natal or nursing mother dental visit

Developmental Measures - v13.0 (cont'd)

▫ Cancer Screening: Pap Smear Rates

- Den: Female Active Clinical patients ages 25 through 64 without documented history of Hysterectomy.
- Num: Patients with a Pap Smear documented in the past 4 years, or if patient is 30 to 64 years of age, either a Pap Smear documented in the past 4 years or a Pap Smear and an HPV DNA documented in the past 6 years. NOTE: This numerator does NOT include refusals.
 - This measure extends the look-back for Pap Smear for 30+ females as long as they also had an HPV DNA

Other CRS Changes

- Updates to Selected Measures Report
 - New measures in GPRA/GPRAMA report also in Selected Measures report
 - Updated Goal Setting measures to look at new Patient Goal file
- New measures added to ONM Report
 - Use of High-Risk Medications in the Elderly

CRS v13.0 patch 1

- National GPRA/GPRAMA report:
 - Adding Childhood Weight Control GPRA measure back into report
 - Diabetes: Nephropathy Assessment: Adding CPT codes 3060F, 3061F, 3062F, 3066F
 - Diabetic Retinopathy: Removed Procedure code 95.02 from Other Eye Exam definition
 - Childhood Immunizations : Removing POV codes from contraindications (MMR and varicella)
 - Cancer Screening: Pap Smear Rates: Added Procedure code 68.9 and POV code 752.43 to hysterectomy definition
 - Cancer Screening: Mammogram Rates: Included logic to allow for two unilateral mastectomies on the same date if the codes include both a right side modifier (RT) and left side modifier (LT)
- GPRA Developmental report:
 - HIV Screening: Changed CD4 measures to look for CD4 count within 90 days of diagnosis (used to be 60 days)

CRS v13.0 patch 1

- ONM report:
 - **Adult Immunizations:** Adding new ages (65+) to Tdap and Td measures
 - **Antidepressant Medication Management:** Removed POV codes 300.4 and 309.1 from major depression definition; Deleted denominator exclusion for patients that had any diagnosis of depression within the previous 120 days of the Index Episode Start Date.
- Selected Measures report:
 - **Removing Community-Acquired Pneumonia topic**
 - **Asthma Quality of Care:** Removed POV code 506.4 from Emphysema definition since it is already included in the COPD definition.
- Other report changes:
 - Update GPRA Performance report to allow user to run report for a designated provider.

CRS v13.0 patch 1 and v13.1

- **CRS v13.0 patch 1**
 - Estimated to be released by March 2013
 - This is the version that will be used for 4th quarter GPRA reporting in July
- **CRS v13.1**
 - This version will be dedicated to ICD-10, and therefore will not be released until October 2013
