The Medical Nutrition Therapy Action Team (MAT)¹ has created an RPMS Electronic Health Record (EHR) template for the Indian Health Service Dietitian that utilizes the nutrition care process (NCP). This template encompasses information from the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics <u>International Dietetics & Nutrition Terminology</u> (IDNT)⊚, 4th edition (2013) and the American Association of Diabetes Educators (AADE) Self Care Behaviors/AADE 7 ™. The IHS DDTP has obtained the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics licensing agreement for the use of the IDNT⊚ and the AADE has given the agency permission to use the (AADE) Self Care Behaviors/AADE 7 ™ in the IHS EHR MNT NCP template.

The 2013 version of the MNT NCP Template was designed to be a "Load and Go" Template. The facility's Clinical Application Coordinator (CAC) is able to easily load the MNT NCP 2013 into the EHR system. Once the template is loaded, the Registered Dietitian (RD) will have the opportunity to immediately begin documenting patient care utilizing the MNT NCP template. The template has been redesigned to be used in pieces – the theory behind this is to have the End User be able to load the large EHR template quickly. In addition, the End User is not bound to complete the entire note in one session. This template provides the option of using only the sections that are appropriate for those patient care services that were provided.



Once the template is loaded into your EHR system, you are ready to begin documentation. Prior to opening the MNT template, enter the POV, CPT code, education, health factors, vitals, chief complaint, exams, personal history and other appropriate patient care activities. By first entering the patient care data, this will allow all pertinent patient data to cross over into the MNT template.










Section A of the MNT Template




















