This webinar will offer practical direction on bridging the gap between medical and oral health care for individuals enduring challenges of oral maxillofacial diseases. Providers will learn the proper referral steps and skills to promote interprofessional collaborations between medical and dental providers.

1. Identify oral manifestations of systemic diseases and their impact on the patient's overall health.
2. Assess for non-odontogenic pain in the head and neck region.
3. Examine oral medicine's scope of practice in the clinical dental and medical setting and the proper referral process.
