



CHAPA-DE GPRA PAPS/MAMMOGRAMS 2013 2012 2011 California






- * In 2013, approximately 207,000 women were diagnosed with breast cancer, with over 40,000 losing the battle.
- * 1 in 8 women will develop breast cancer during their lifetime.
- * In 2013, over 12,000 women in the U.S. were diagnosed with cervical cancer, with approximately 4,000 succumbing to the disease.
- * The number of cervical cancer cases has decreased by approximately 50% in the last 40 years due to regular Pap screenings! This number has further decreased due to the recent ability to test for HPV (Human Papilloma Virus).
