

How to Determine if Your Site Has the Certified Version of the Dental/EDR Interface V1.2, Patch 1

October 12, 2012

The EDR Team has discovered that many sites running EDR have not installed the certified & released version of BADE Patch 1 which is available from the IHS ftp site at <ftp.ihs.gov/rpsmn/patches>. The steps outlined below can be used to determine if a site has installed the certified & released version of Patch 1 for the Dental/EDR Interface (BADE). It should be used by qualified IT site stall who would routinely load RPMS software and patches at a facility.

Log in to the RPMS system as you normally would.

- If your main menu does not contain the Programmer Options menu, contact your supervisor.
- If you menu does have this option, choose Programmer Options and press <return>. Continue through the menu structure choosing the items indicated in **BOLD**.

Now you must indicate which package to display, so type in BADE at the Package Name prompt below. Continue through the choices, typing what is displayed in BOLD.

If your display does not show information pertaining to A40 merge messages and migration from BEE to BADE as highlighted above in BOLD then YOU DO NOT HAVE THE CERTIFIED & RELEASED VERSION. Obtain the certified patch from ftp.ihs.gov/rpms/patches. There are three files with this patch. They are:

- BADE0100.01i.pdf – Installation guide and notes. READ THIS ENTIRE DOCUMENT THOROUGHLY!!
- BADE0100.01K – KIDS install file
- EDR_ENSRPMS_A40PATCH.XML – Ensemble interface component of Patch 1.

Failure to read and follow all instructions and release notes when loading this patch will result in Dental visits not being created in PCC.

IMPORTANT

IF YOU HAVE BADE V1.0, PATCH 1 INSTALLED AND YOUR DISPLAY LOOKS SIMILAR TO THE SECTION HIGHLIGHTED IN BOLD BELOW THEN YOU DO NOT HAVE THE CERTIFIED & RELEASED VERSION. Obtain the certified patch from ftp.ihs.gov/rpms/patches. Read the entire installation guide and follow the instructions closely. Failing to do so will result in Dental visits not being created in PCC.

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Troubleshooting Questions for Discussion?

1. User is notified for no E&M Code when on Inpatient Unit. He wants to be notified when in Clinic, but not when on Inpatient Unit. ***How can you stop this for this Provider?***
2. A site has implemented BCMA (Bar Code Medication Administration) and wants the BCMA Med Log and BCMA Med Admin History to display on the Reports Tab. ***How can you add these to the Report List?***
3. When running the menu option, *MUCD Establish Meaningful Use 'Clean Date'* it fails. ***How can you determine what Order Checks are Enabled/Disabled at your site?***
4. In the last example we set “List All Health Summary” to “No.” ***Can this be accomplished another way?***
