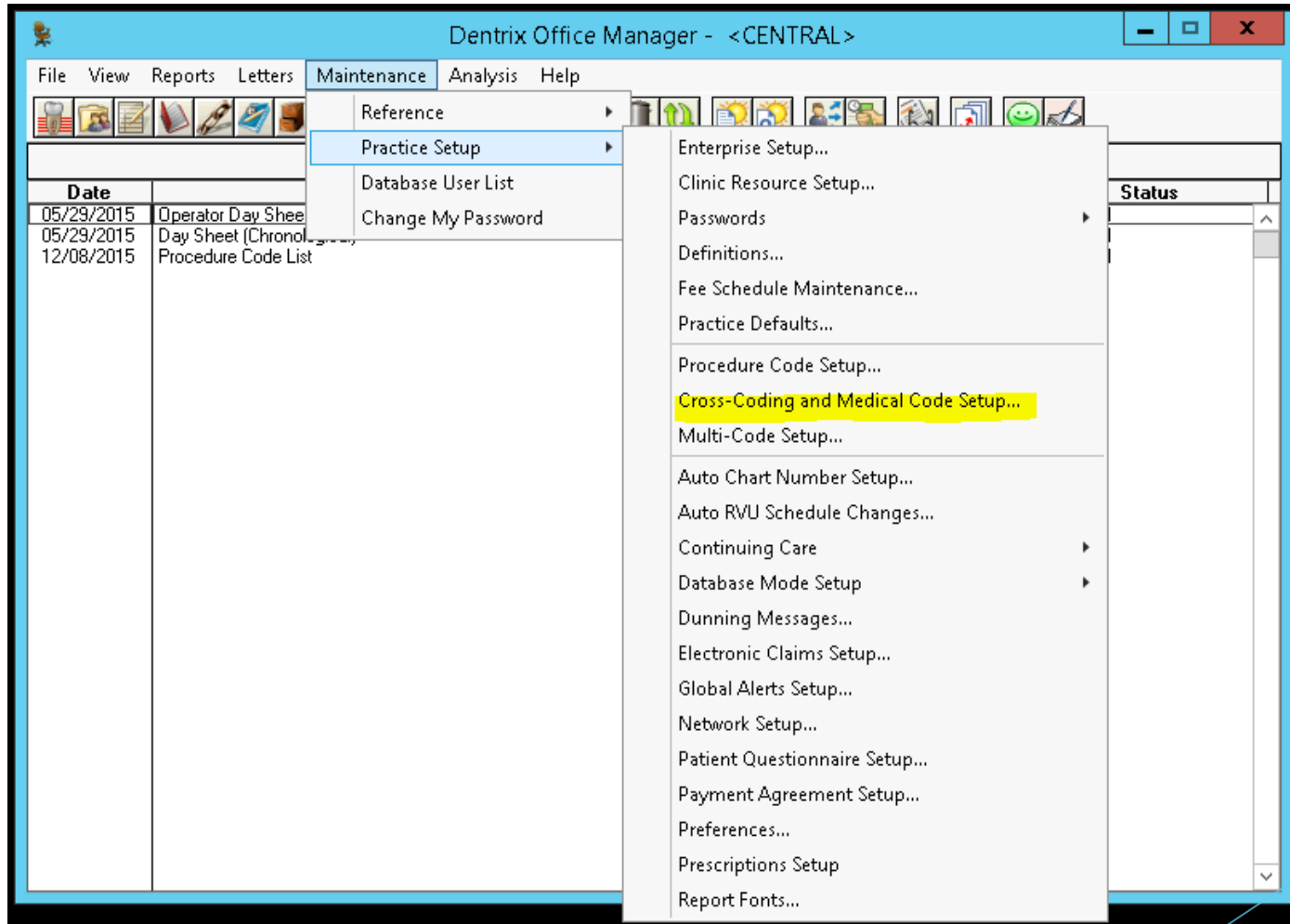


# Dentrix ICD-10 Codes

How to Guide

Updated February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018

From the Dentrix Office Manager; in the <CENTRAL> clinic [so they will apply to all clinics]; click on **Maintenance -> Practice Setup -> Cross Coding and Medical Code Setup**



Click on **Cross Code Setup**; then select 'CDT' from **Cross code for:** and select 'ICD-10-CM' from **Link to:**

# Points to Ponder

- ▶ You can directly complete procedures that have default ICD-10 codes.
- ▶ You must treatment plan procedures that do not have default codes and then add the ICD-10 code prior to completing the procedure.
- ▶ Communicate with your coder regarding this process change, they may have some more tips to make your life easier.
- ▶ If you select no ICD-10 code, ZZZ.999 is the default.
- ▶ **\*\*Please remember that you cannot modify a **Completed** procedure, you must delete the procedure and add a new procedure.\*\***
