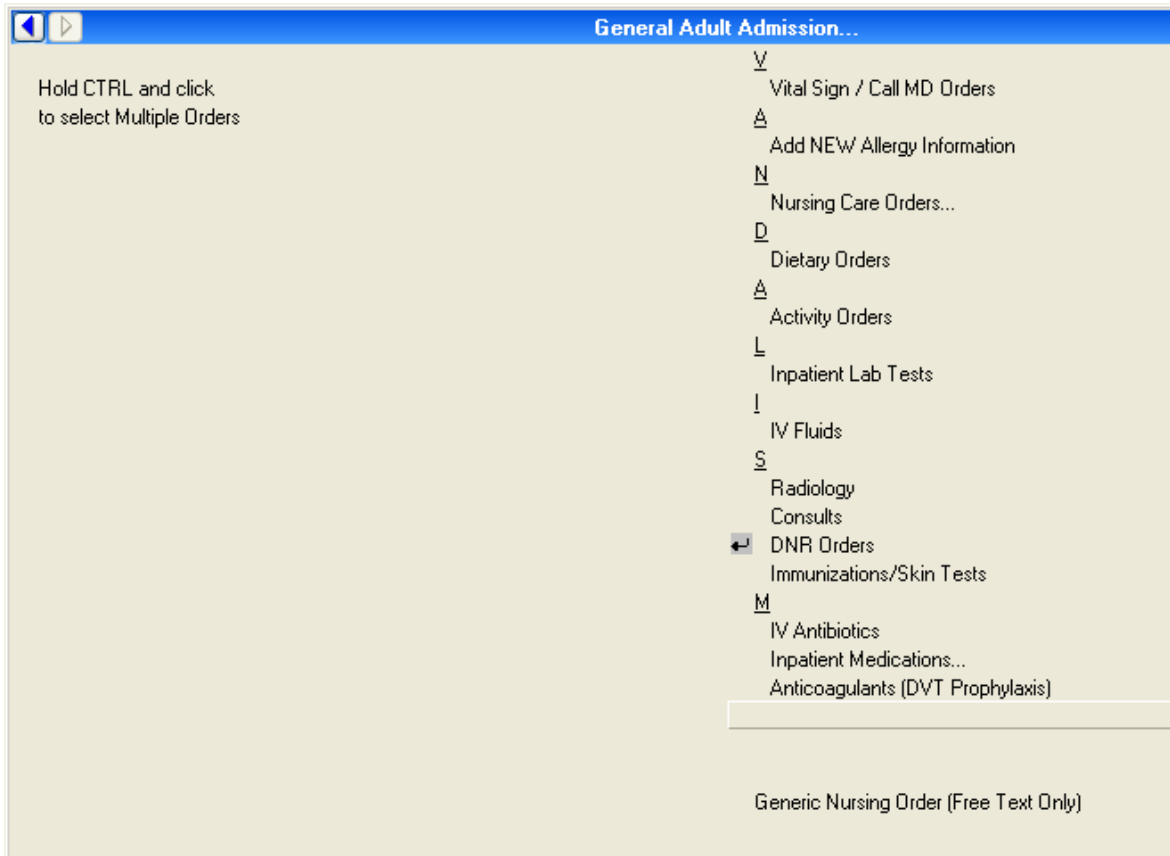
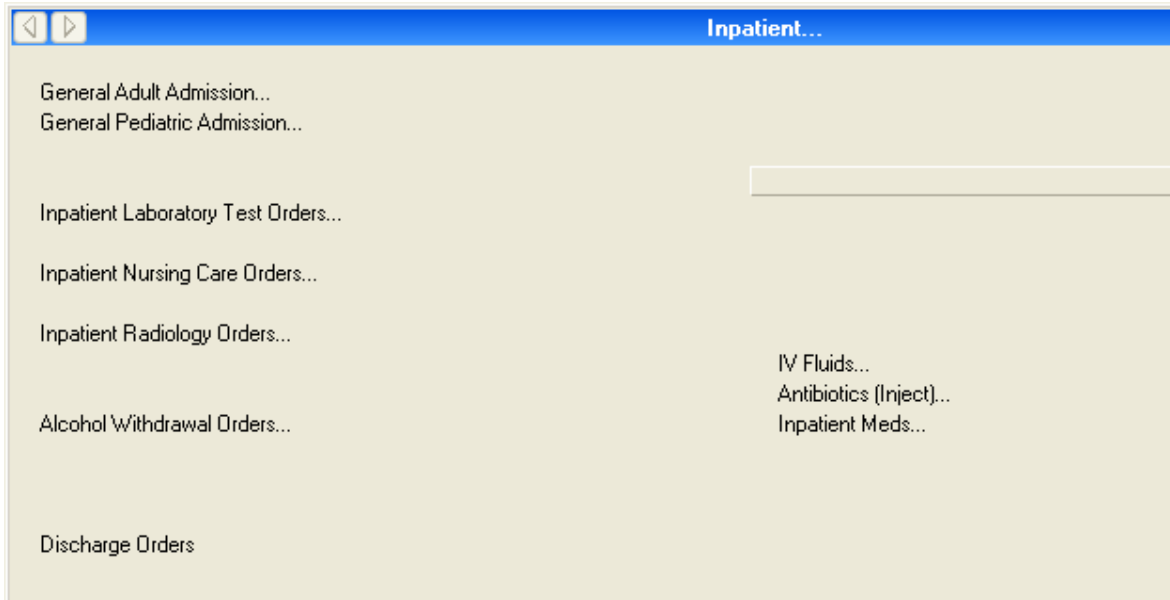



- If CIWA Score >25 transfer to an ICU
 - Nursing Staff to Initiate Referral to Mental Health: "Assess Alcohol Rehab"
 - Nursing Staff to Initiate Referral to Psychiatrist On Call
- Baseline Labs: CMP / HFP / Mag / Phos / Ethanol / CBC / Urine DAS
 Subsequent Labs: BMP / Mag / Phos x 2 Days

Thiamine 100mg and MVI (default:Sodium Chloride 0.9%) daily until tolerating PO
 Thiamine 100mg PO (or IV in 1 L Normal saline) daily for 2 days.
 Multivitamin with minerals (PNV) PO Daily when patient taking orals.

- PPD Skin Test Now. Evaluate in 48 & 72 hours.
- Pneumovax 0.5 mL (Adult) IM Now

Choose one drug (Diazepam/Lorazepam). Multiple routes acceptable.
 If "Scheduled" method selected MUST also check at least one PRN method.

Diazepam (Valium) May accumulate and cause prolonged sedation
 in elderly or severe liver disease patients.

DIAZEPAM

"PRN" Diazepam (5 to 20mg recommended) PO/IV q1h prn CIWA 8 or greater
 "Scheduled" Diazepam (10 to 20mg recommended) PO/IV Taper over 4 days
 "PCU High Dose PRN" Diazepam 20mg Hourly prn CIWA 8 or greater

LORAZEPAM

"PRN" Lorazepam (1 to 4mg) PO/IV/IM q30min PRN CIWA 8 or greater
 "Scheduled" Lorazepam (2 to 4mg) PO/IV Tapered over 4 days.
 "PCU High Dose PRN" Lorazepam 4mg IV push q30min prn CIWA 8 or greater

Adjunctive Medications

Haloperidol (2.5 to 5mg) PO/IV/IM q2h for agitation.
 Atenolol 50mg PO Daily. Hold for HR<50 or SBP<100
 Chlordiazepoxide 50mg PO QID and at bedtime for CIWA >15

Alcohol Withdrawal Assessment Protocol

- A. Vitals, CIWA score now. Use assessment sheet for documentation.
- B. If initial CIWA score is 8 or greater, continue assessment and vitals q 1h x 8h, then if stable q 2h x 8h, then if stable q 4h thereafter.
- C. If initial CIWA score < 8, continue assessment q 4h x 72h. If CIWA score < 8 for 72 hours, discontinue assessment. If CIWA score 8 or greater, go to (b) above.
- D. If indicated, administer medications as ordered above.
- E. Call provider for assessment, consider transfer to ICU for any of the following:
CIWA score above 20, q 1h assessment x more than 8h required,
more than 6mg/h Lorazepam x 3h or 10 mg/h Diazepam x 3h required,
or respiratory distress.
- F. Call MD for any of the following:
Temp > 101.5
SBP > 160, < 90
DBP > 100
HR > 150, < 60
RR > 30
