## Health Information Management Stage 1 Meaningful Use Core Set Electronic Copy of Health Information

**PURPOSE**: The purpose of this policy is to specify Indian Health Service (IHS) policy and procedures related to Meaningful Use Electronic Copy of Health Information.

**POLICY**: It is IHS policy that facilities establish both policies and procedures that pertain to Electronic Copy of Health Information in the Resource and Patient Management System Electronic Health Record (RPMS EHR).

**OBJECTIVE**: Provide patients with an electronic copy of their health information (including diagnostic test results, problem list, medication lists, medication allergies), upon request.

**MEASURE**: More than 50% of all patients of the eligible provider (EP) or the inpatient or emergency departments of the eligible hospital's (EH) or Critical Access Hospital's (CAH) (POS 21 or 23\*) who request an electronic copy of their health information, are provided it within three business days.

**PROCEDURES**: The following procedures shall be followed by the Health Information Management professional:

- 1. Ensure the facility's Clinical Applications Coordinator (CAC) creates a Patient Wellness Handout that contains the problem list, medication list, medication allergies, and lab results and make this report available in EHR.
- 2. Upon request for an electronic copy of health information, the patient shall complete and sign the authorization form IHS-810 *Authorization for Use or Disclosure of Protected Health Information* at <u>http://www.ihs.gov/CIO/PUF/</u> or <u>http://intranet.hhs.gov/forms</u> (IHS staff only).
- 3. The form and format should be human readable and comply with the HIPAA Privacy Rule. Refer to IHS HIPAA Privacy policies and procedures *Authorization or Valid Written Request* (http://www.ihs.gov/ihm/index.cfm?module=dsp\_ihm\_pc\_p2c7\_ex\_d) and *Access, Inspect, and Obtain a Copy of Their Protected Health Information* at: http://www.ihs.gov/ihm/index.cfm?module=dsp\_ihm\_pc\_p2c7\_ex\_a).
- 4. Provide the information to the patient in an electronic format such as by CD provided by the facility or encrypted e-mail within three business days.
- 5. It is imperative to account for the disclosure in the Release of Information application to meet the Meaningful Use measure by entering the following:
  - a. The Date Request Initiated and Patient/Agent Request Type: Electronic
  - b. The Disclosure Date and Record Dissemination: Electronic

## \*POS (Place of Service) Codes:

• **21** – **Inpatient hospital**: A facility, other than psychiatric, which primarily provides diagnostic, therapeutic (both surgical and nonsurgical), and rehabilitation services by, or under, the supervision of physicians to patients admitted for a variety of medical conditions.

• **23** – **Emergency room-hospital**: A portion of a hospital where emergency diagnosis and treatment of illness or injury is provided.
