## NEW PROCESS for digital cameras interfacing with VistA Imaging

Cameras have almost become a general computing device in the VistA Imaging environment. Digital cameras developed after 2004 with a minimum of 4 megapixels picture resolution are considered approved for use with VistA Imaging when the following required paperwork is received by the VistA Imaging Team:

- Image Acquisition Technical Datasheet
- Image Quality Certification

The Image Quality Certification form must be completed and signed by a doctor or qualified clinician appropriate to the intended use of the camera.

## It is the responsibility of the doctor or clinician to determine that the camera's picture resolution is appropriate for the intended use.

The Technical Datasheet and Image Quality Certification must be sent to the IHS VistA Imaging Program Management office.

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
