

## **NEW PROCESS for digital cameras interfacing with VistA Imaging**

Cameras have almost become a general computing device in the VistA Imaging environment. Digital cameras developed after 2004 with a minimum of 4 megapixels picture resolution are considered approved for use with VistA Imaging when the following required paperwork is received by the VistA Imaging Team:

- Image Acquisition Technical Datasheet
- Image Quality Certification

The Image Quality Certification form must be completed and signed by a doctor or qualified clinician appropriate to the intended use of the camera.

**It is the responsibility of the doctor or clinician to determine that the camera's picture resolution is appropriate for the intended use.**

The Technical Datasheet and Image Quality Certification must be sent to the IHS VistA Imaging Program Management office.
