Photo Capture Steps	Pass/Needs Review
Create the patient identifier ruler. This can be an index card or a ruler. This must contain 2 forms of identification (e.g., Health Record number and Date of Birth)	
Place the patient identifier into the field of vision and take the picture (s).	
 Some images may require zoom/macro. These must be taken using optical zoom, not digital zoom. The patient identification card may not fit into the field of vision. In this case: 1. Zoom out to include the patient identifier 2. Zoom in to take a close up without the patient identifier 3. Zoom out to include the patient identifier. This creates a series of images that will be imported as a batch in subsequent steps. 	
Immediately connect the camera to a workstation, or place memory card in card reader	
Start EHR. Open the Capture window from the Imaging toolbar.	
Select the progress note that you want to attach the image to.	
Import the image using the Import button or the Import Batch button. These buttons may be named differently at your site.	
Populate the specialty and the procedure/event fields.	
Navigate to the import folder (lower left) and locate your camera device.	
Select the image(s).	
Review the image. Verify that you have the correct patient and progress note selected.
