# **Indian Health Service** FY 2024 Budget Update

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## FY 2024 Continuing Resolution

On September 30, Congress enacted the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2024 and Other Extensions Act, providing funding through November 17.

- The Continuing Resolution provides funding for 48 days, which is 13.11% of the FY 2023 Enacted Level.
- The bill also extends the Special Diabetes Program for Indians through November 17, providing an additional \$19.7 million for the program.

## FY 2024 Continuing Resolution (Cont.)

Activities that did not receive advance appropriations received funding in the FY 2024 Continuing Resolution.



### FY 2024 Advance Appropriations

All IHS budget lines that received an FY 2024 advance appropriation are funded at the FY 2023 Enacted level.

- In a final FY 2024 spending bill, Congress could elect to build on the FY 2024 advance appropriation and adjust funding levels for the IHS.
- The IHS is now in the process of making payments to Title I/V Tribes and UIOs with October-September (fiscal year) performance periods.

#### Payment Updates

The IHS reopened its financial systems for FY 2024 activities on Tuesday, Oct 3. This is the <u>earliest that the IHS has ever</u> <u>reopened</u> for a new fiscal year since the Unified Financial Management System was implemented in 2007. The IHS also:

- Pre-loaded FY 2024 data into the financial system, and was subsequently able to distribute funding all the way to the local level that same day; and
- Modified system planning so that Areas could input Title I and Title V payment data before the new FY, finding new efficiencies in the process for making payments for FY 2024.

#### Payment Updates

Tribes with Fiscal Year ISDEAA Title I/V Agreements should start seeing payments in the next several days. To receive a payment:

- Title I Tribes must have a signed ISDEAA contract and annual funding agreement in place to receive a FY 2024 payment.
- Similarly, Title V Tribes must have a signed ISDEAA compact and funding agreement in place to receive a FY 2024 payment.
- UIOs must have a signed FAR contract in place to receive a FY 2024 payment. Payment will be made in accordance with contract interim or advance payment terms and contract financing requirements.

## Payment Processes (Cont.)

Making payments under the advance appropriation requires the same partnership between IHS, Tribes, and Urban Indian Organizations as prior fiscal years.

- The IHS has taken steps to ensure that all of the steps that the Agency must take to issue FY 2024 payments can be completed as expeditiously as possible.
- The IHS is available to provide support to any Tribe or UIO that needs assistance completing the required steps on their end to receive an FY 2024 payment.
