

Meaningful Use: Stage 1, 2013 Performance Measures

To demonstrate Meaningful Use for 2013, Eligible Professionals (EPs) and Eligible Hospitals (EHs) must meet the following criteria:

Eligible Professionals

- 13 Core Objectives (Performance Measures)
- 5 out of 10 Menu Objectives (Performance Measures)
- 6 CQMs (3 core or alternate core if zero denominator plus 3 from additional set)

Eligible Hospitals

- 12 Core Objectives (Performance Measures)
- 5 out of 10 Menu Objectives (Performance Measures)
- 15 CQMs

Note: EH measures are also applicable to CAHs.

| • | • | CPOE | More than 30% of medication orders created are recorded using CPOE (computerized provider order entry). |
| • | • | Drug Interaction Checks | The EP/EH has enabled this functionality for the entire EHR reporting period. (Yes/No) |
| • | • | Maintain Problem List | More than 80% of all unique patients seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient or emergency department* have at least one entry (or an indication that no problems are known for the patient) recorded as structured data. |
| • | • | Maintain Active Medication List | More than 80% of all unique patients seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient or emergency department* have at least one entry (or an indication that the patient is not currently prescribed any medication) recorded as structured data. |
| • | • | Medication Allergy List | More than 80% of all unique patients seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient or emergency department* EH have at least one entry (or an indication that the patient has no know medication allergies) recorded as structured data. |
| • | • | Record Demographics | More than 50% of all unique patients seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient or emergency department* have demographics recorded as structured data. |
| • | • | Record Vital Signs | More than 50% of all unique patients age 2 and over seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient or emergency department* have height, weight, and blood pressure recorded as structured data. |
| • | • | Record Smoking Status | More than 50% of all unique patients 13 years old or older seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient emergency department* have smoking status recorded as structured data. |
| • | • | Clinical Decision Support Rule | Implement one clinical decision support rule. (Yes/No) |
| • | • | Electronic Copy of Health Information | More than 50% of all patients of the EP or patients of the EH's inpatient or emergency department* who <u>request</u> an electronic copy of their health information are provided it within 3 business days. |
| • | • | Protect Electronic Health Information | Conduct or review a security risk analysis in accordance with the requirements under 45 CFR 164.308(a)(1) and implement security updates as necessary and correct identified security deficiencies as part of its risk management process.(Yes/No) |
| • | | eRx | More than 40% of all permissible prescriptions written by the EP are transmitted electronically using certified EHR technology. |
| • | | Clinical Summaries | Clinical summaries provided to patients for more than 50% of all office visits within 3 business days. |
| | • | Electronic Copy of Discharge Instructions | More than 50% of all patients who are discharged from an EH's inpatients department or emergency department* and who request an electronic copy of their discharge instructions are provided it. |

| • | • | Drug Formulary | The EP/EH has enabled this functionality and has access to at least one internal or external formulary for the entire EHR reporting period. (Yes/No) |
| • | • | Clinical Lab Test Results | More than 40% of all clinical lab test results ordered by the EP or by the EH for patients admitted to the inpatient or emergency department* during the EHR reporting period whose results are either in a positive/negative or numerical format are incorporated in certified EHR technology as structured data. |
| • | • | Patient Lists | Generate at least one report listing patients of the EP/EH with a specific condition. (Yes/No) |
| • | • | Patient-Specific Education Resources | More than 10% of all unique patients seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient or emergency department* are provided patient-specific education resources |
| • | • | Medication Reconciliation | Medication reconciliation is performed for more than 50% of transitions of care in which the patient is seen by the EP or admitted to the EH's inpatient or emergency department*. |
| • | • | Transition of Care Summary | The EP/EH who transitions or refers their patient to another setting of care or provider of care provides a summary of care record for more than 50% of transitions of care and referrals. |
| • | | Patient Reminders | More than 20% of all unique patients 65 years or older or 5 years old or younger were sent an appropriate reminder during the EHR reporting period. |
| • | | Patient Electronic Access | More than 10% of all unique patients seen by the EP are provided timely (available to the patient within four business days of being updated in the certified EHR technology) electronic access to their health information subject to the EP's discretion to withhold certain information. |
| | • | Reportable Lab Results to Public Health Agency | Performed at least one test of certified EHR technology's capacity to provide electronic submission or reportable lab results to public health agencies and follow-up submission if the test is successful (unless none of the public health agencies to which the EH submits such information have the capacity to receive the information electronically). (Yes/No) |
| | • | Advance Directives | More than 50% of all unique patients 65 years old or older admitted to the EH's inpatient department (POS 21) have an indication of an advance directive status recorded. |
| • | • | Immunization Registries Data Submission | Performed at least one test of certified EHR technology's capacity to submit electronic data to immunization registries and follow up submission if the test is successful (unless none of the immunization registries to which the EP/EH submits such information has the capacity to receive the information electronically). (Yes/No) |
| • | • | Syndromic Surveillance | Performed at least one test of certified EHR technology's capacity to provide electronic syndromic surveillance data to public health agencies and follow-up submission if the test is successful (unless none of the public health agencies to which an EP/EH submits such information has the capacity to receive the information electronically). (Yes/No) |

*Inpatient and emergency room departments are defined as POS 21 and POS 23.
